Casa Bonay

Casa Bonay is more than a hotel. It's a way of life that, over the years, has built a community sharing values around sustainability, social wellbeing and authenticity. The project was born in a neoclassical building from 1869 in the centre of Barcelona, creating a space that blurs the line between home and hotel.

We believe in the importance of stopping and sharing time, whether around a table or in the calm offered by Termas, an open-air social wellness club conceived for enjoying in company or unwinding after a long journey. Gastronomy runs through everything we do – not simply a service, but part of our DNA, from the products we craft to the local produce we choose.

We've grown by collaboration with local tradesmen – chefs, landscapers, industrial designers and artists – staying true to a local, honest and sustainable approach in every decision, from the suppliers we work with to the choice to preserve what already exists rather than replace it. We believe this way of doing things gives meaning to our everyday, and has allowed us to build an identity rooted in community and closeness that makes travellers and neighbours alike feel genuinely part of it.





Rooms

We restored this beautiful 1869 house, conserving its original hydraulic flooring “Nolla”, its ceilings, and its sliding doors, and we added a few touches of our own: we installed our favourite lamps from Santa & Cole, we filled the minibars according to our favourite cravings and, along with Marc from AOO, we designed the furniture – all to create the hotel we would love to enjoy ourselves. We hope you do too.

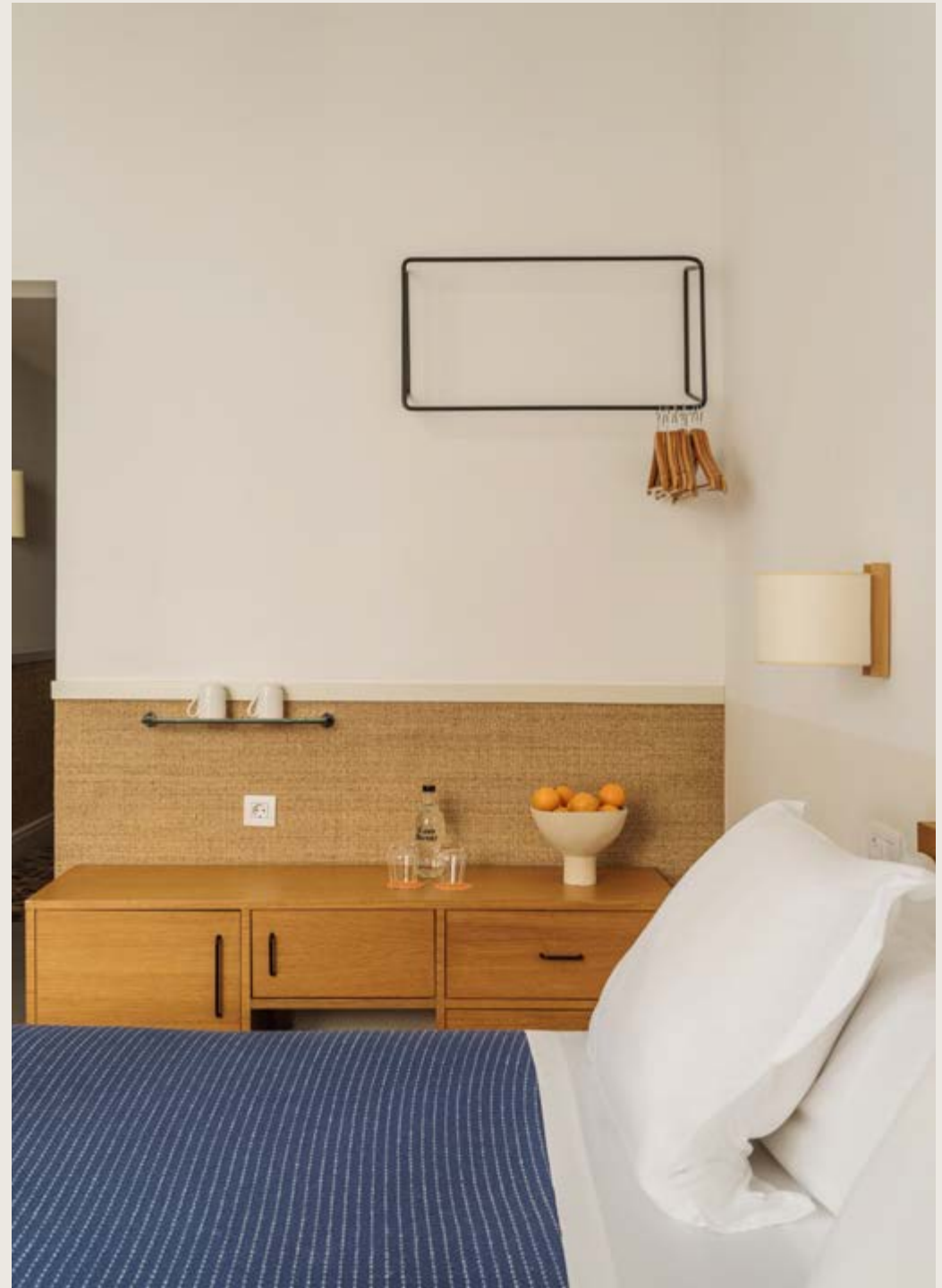

Total: 6 rooms SqfT: 172 Sleeps 2

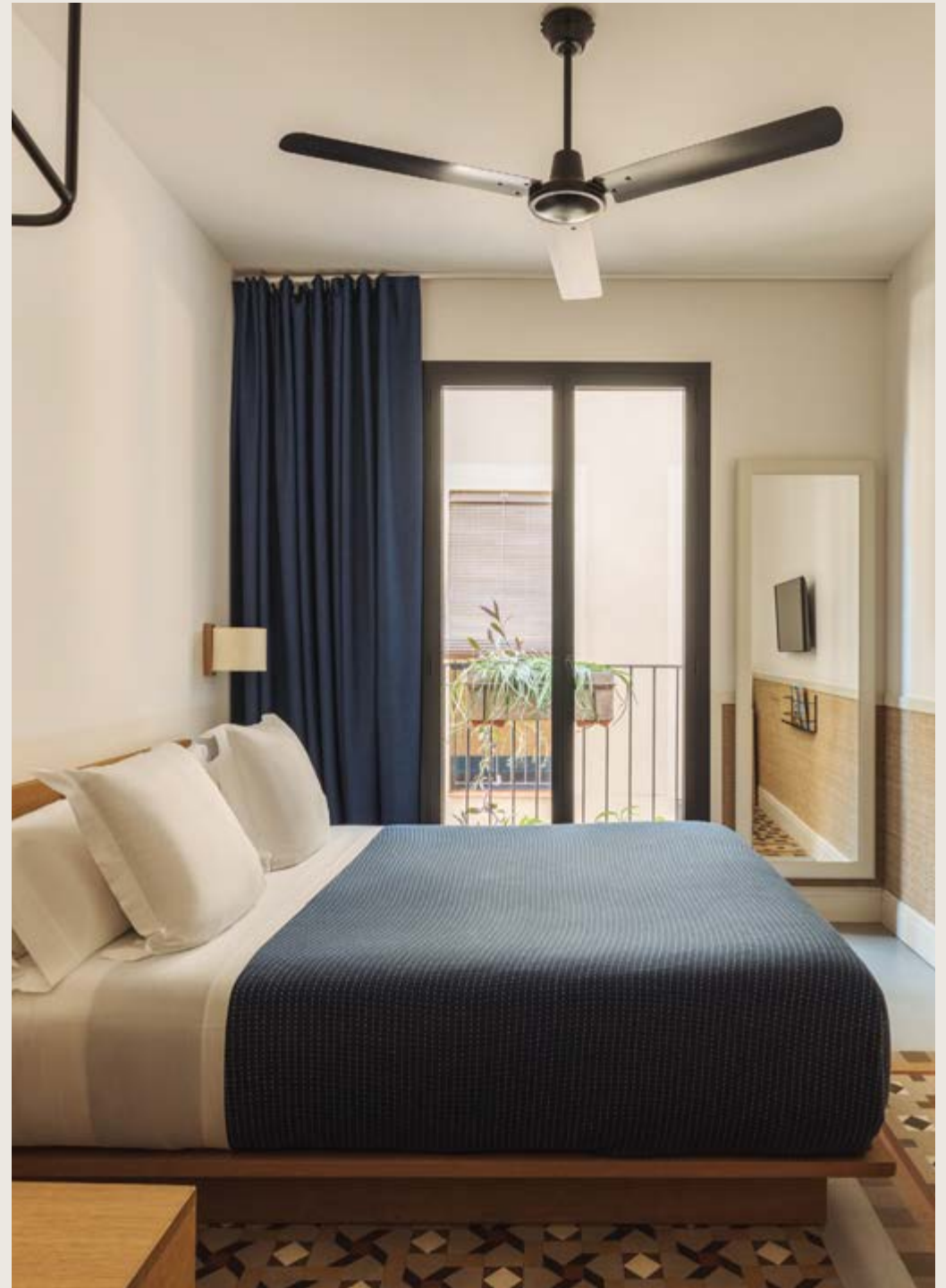

Total: 12 rooms SqfT: 193 Sleeps 2

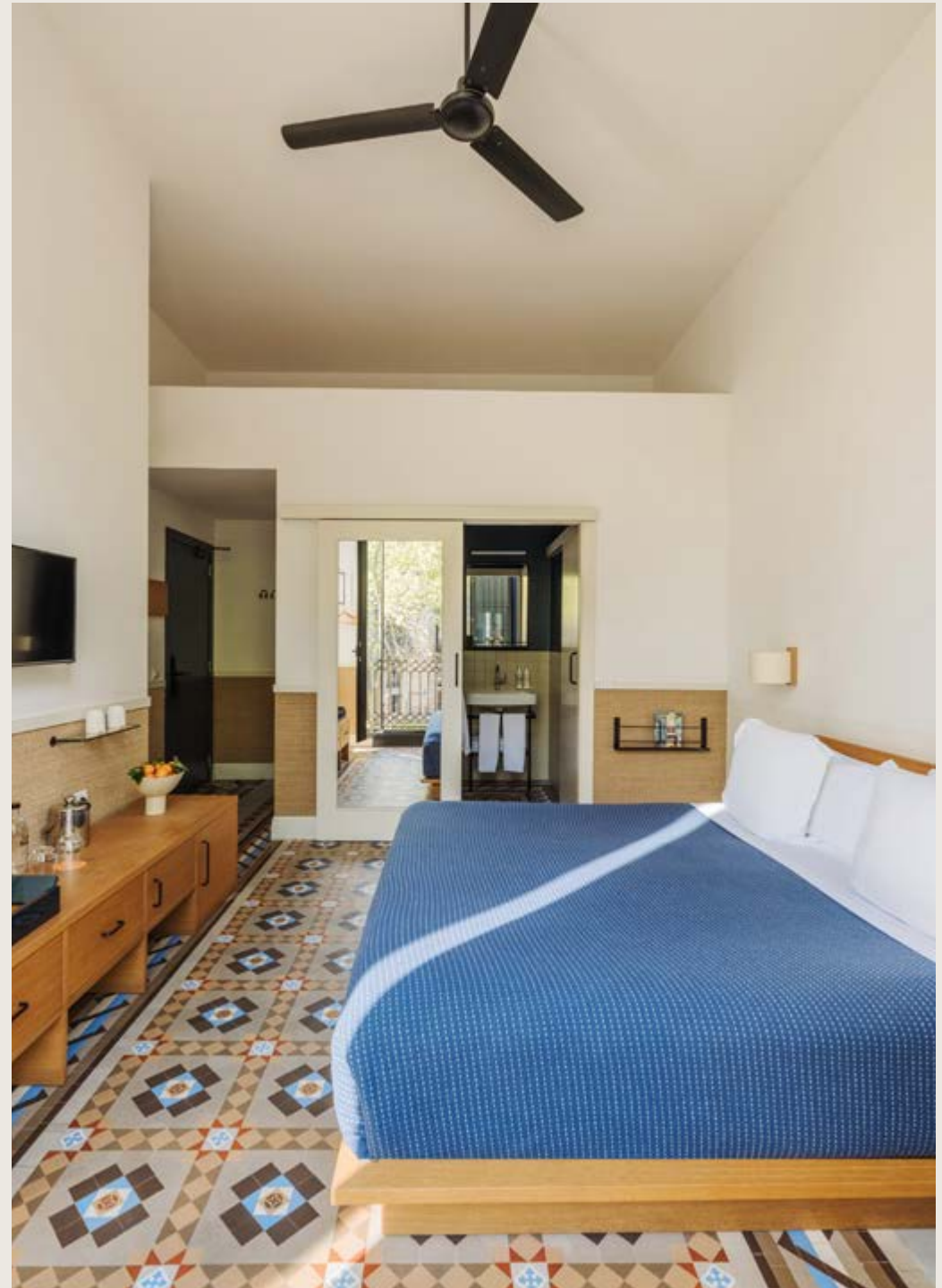

Total: 10 rooms SqfT: 204 Sleeps 2

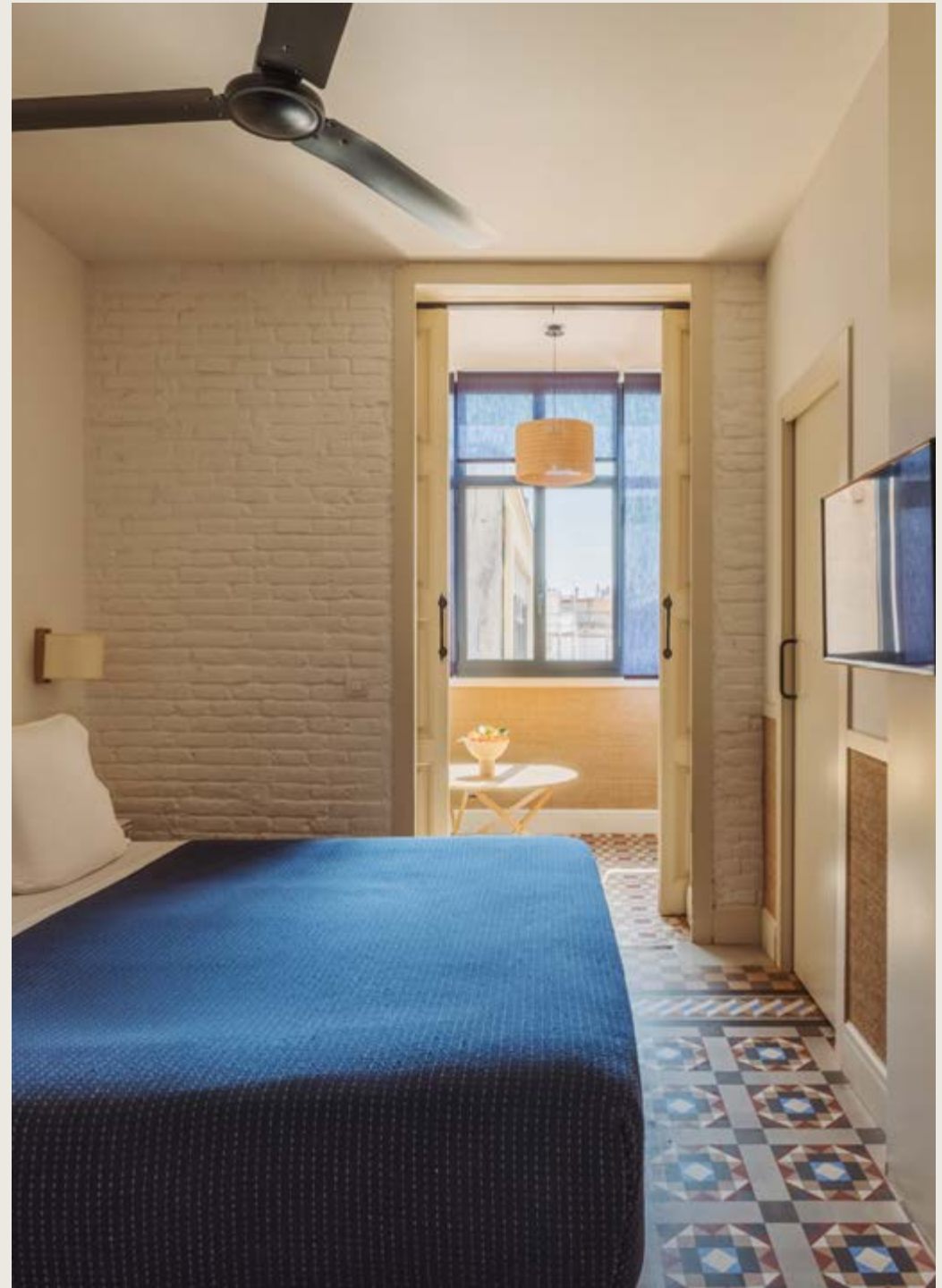

Courtyard Medium

Total: 9 rooms SqfT: 215 Sleeps 2

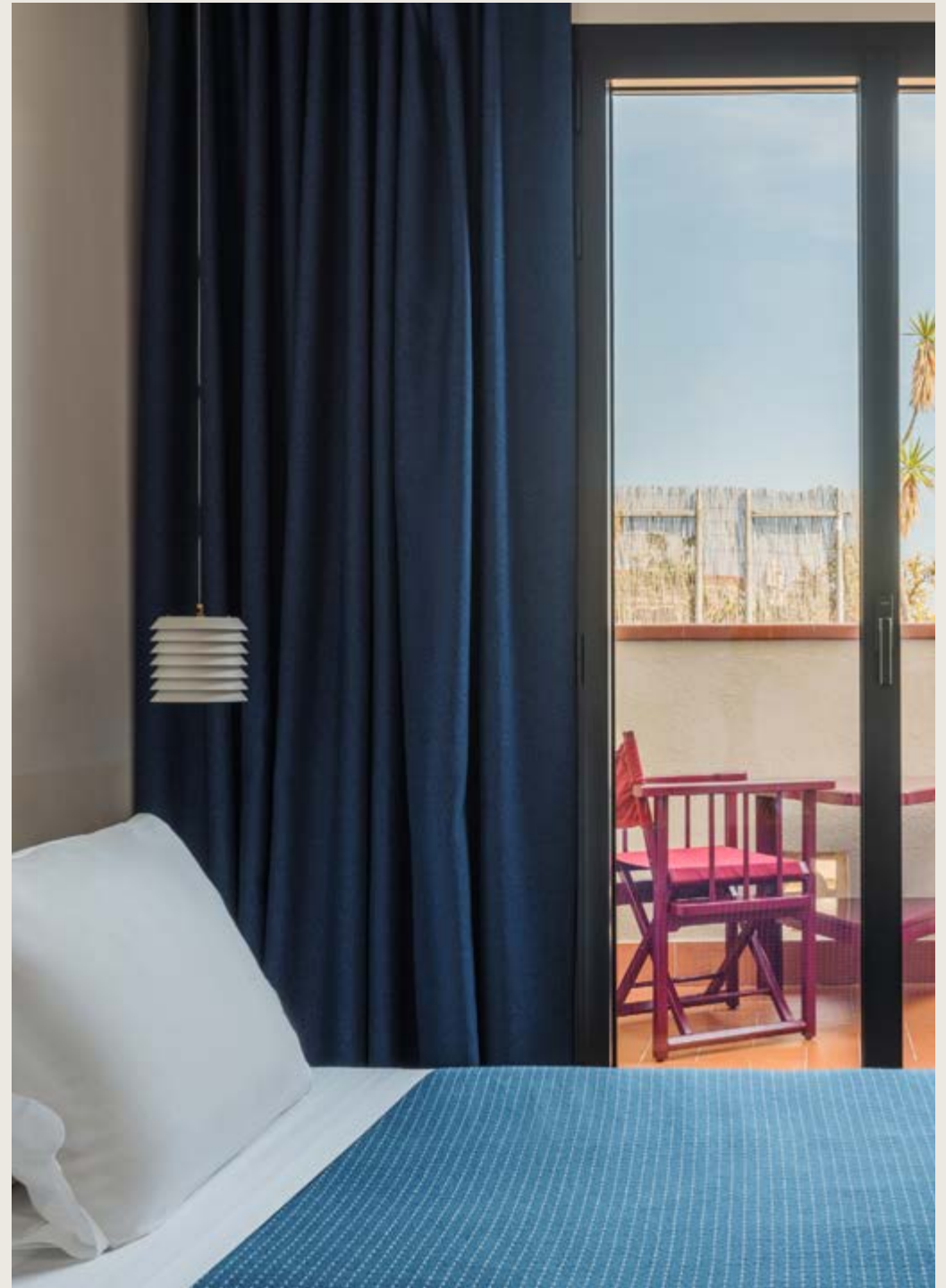
Overlooking the traditional courtyards of Eixample with original glass-windowed galleries, these rooms which feature a king-sized, rainfall shower also have a separate sofa area, bathed in sunlight. They also have high ceilings and original mosaic flooring and feature a minibar full of delicious drinks and local snacks.



Courtyard Mini Terrace

Total: 5 rooms SqfT: 139 Sleeps 2

For those seeking outdoor space, these king-bed rooms overlook the traditional courtyards of Eixample and are situated on the top floor. Whilst the bedroom area is compact, their outdoor terraces offer brilliant views of the courtyard and of the city. Their floors are made of traditional terracotta tiles and they enjoy an incredible amount of natural light. They feature a minibar full of delicious drinks and local snacks.



Gran Via Large

Total: 15 rooms SqfT: 226 Sleeps 3

For groups of three or young families, these King-bed rooms, with sofa bed overlook the Gran Vía. They have high ceilings and feature a minibar full of delicious drinks and local snacks and yoga kit.



Courtyard Large

Total: 3 rooms SqfT: 365 Sleeps 3

For groups of three or young families, these king-bed rooms, with sofa bed overlook the traditional courtyards of Eixample. Spacious and homely, they are ideal for longer stays. They include an independent room with a sofa bed and a glass-windowed gallery that allow for year-round views over a typical Barcelona courtyard. They feature a minibar full of delicious drinks and local snacks and yoga kit.



Courtyard Large Terrace

Total: 5 rooms SqfT: 226 Sleeps 2

For those seeking outdoor space, to enjoy time in the room and the Mediterranean sun, these king-bed rooms have their own private terrace with an exterior shower and deck chairs. Located on the first floor, they have high ceilings and floors made of original mosaics. They feature a minibar full of delicious drinks and local snacks and yoga kit.



Termas

Termas Outdoor Spa is a social wellness club built around a contrast circuit. The space includes a dry sauna with red light therapy, ice bath, hammam and ofuro, along with two treatment cabins for massages.

An intimate open-air retreat surrounded by greenery, adding elements like sun, the scent of plants and the sound of birds to the contrast experience — a unique experience in the centre of Barcelona. The botanical setting evokes Mediterranean gardens and dreamlike atmospheres, bringing together design, sustainability and landscape in one sensory experience.

All of it guided by a single principle: leave better than you arrived.

Food and wine at Bonay, an organic relationship

Food and drink; in fundamental in our makeup — local, honest, and artisanal, working with nearby suppliers to support a circular economy that gives back to our community and city. Across our four outlets — Chiringuito, Bodega, TosTao, and Libertine — that philosophy takes on a different shape in each space, from rooftop grill to late-night cocktail bar.

We've been a destination for wine lovers since day one. Our cellar now runs to 250 references, with a special focus on Spain — from Lanzarote to Madrid — and our neighbour to the north, France. Hand-picked by our team, our selection favours variety, gastronomic compatibility, and discovery, spotlighting lesser-known winemakers whose organic practices are changing the world of wine from the inside out.



Our restaurant and cocktail bar (50 Best Discovery) is open all day, every day of the week with weekend hours until 02.30h. Here you can catch an all-day dining menu, high end cocktail offering and an array of events from weekly, local and international DJs to round table talks and family activations.
